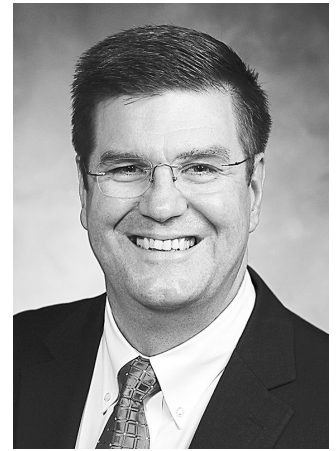

The Rev. Jeff Thiemann

Pastor Thiemann has a computer science engineering degree from Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Cambridge and is a graduate of Harvard Business School's General Manager Program for Executive Education in Boston. He spent a first career as a strategic consultant, a CEO of a tech start up in Silicon Valley and before that, as a Hewlett Packard general manager. He felt the call to ministry and recognized a need for his skills in the church. He grew up in the Philippines and Ethiopia as the son of missionaries and was always active in the church. In 2005 he was ordained after graduating from Pacific Lutheran Theological Seminary in Berkley, California. He and his wife, Pam, are the parents to four children. Pastor Thiemann has spoken at numerous Synod Assemblies and other leadership venues.



Antiochian Village and Conference Center

Antiochian Village is located on 300 rural acres in the beautiful Laurel Highlands region of southwestern Pennsylvania just 6 miles north of the historic town of Ligonier. Antiochian Village hosts a wide variety of groups, families, retreats, business conferences, reunions, weddings, and sports camps. Owned and operated by the Antiochian Orthodox Christian Archdiocese of North America, headquartered in Englewood, NJ, Antiochian Village Conference Center has been in operation since 1985.

The Conference Center offers 100 hotel-style lodging rooms, 18 fully-equipped meeting rooms including a sloped lecture style auditorium with seating for 140, a full service banquet facility with seating for up to 350, a Bookstore & Gift Shop, fitness and business centers, walking trails, a theological library and heritage museum.

What to bring

We will have ample free time on Tuesday afternoon. There are many local attractions as well as on-site trails for biking and hiking. The Auditorium is often very cool; bring a sweater. Meals are ample and we will seek to accommodate a variety of needs. Coffee, tea, and water will be provided throughout the day.
